INTERPRETATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Interpretation (Amendment) Ordinance 1977*.^{*} Short title.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 July 1977. Commence-
ment.

3. Section 14 of the *Interpretation Ordinance 1967*[†] is amended by Definitions.
omitting the definition of "the *Gazette*" and substituting the following
definition:—

" 'the *Gazette* ' means the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette*,
and includes the *Australian Government Gazette* published
during the period commencing on 1 July 1973 and ending
on 30 June 1977;".

4. Section 14A of the *Interpretation Ordinance 1967* is amended by inserting, before the words " 'Government Printer of Australia' ",
the words " 'Government Printer of the Commonwealth', 'Government
Printer of the Commonwealth of Australia', 'Commonwealth Govern-
ment Printer' or ". Paper or
document

to be printed
by
Government
Printer.
