REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Amendment) Ordinance 1977*.* Short title
2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Ordinance 1963*.† Principal Ordinance
3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 3 October 1977. Commence-

4. Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) the symbol and figure "\$2" and substituting the symbol and figure "\$3". Registration

 - (a) by omitting from sub-section (4) the words "Two dollars" and substituting the symbol and figure "\$4";
and
 - (b) by omitting from sub-section (7) the words "Fifty cents" and substituting the symbol and figure "\$3".
