MOTOR TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 6) 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 6) 1977*.* Short title
2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory by notice in the *Gazette*. Commencement
3. Section 163C of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936*† is amended— Parking fees
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (2) (a) “Five cents” and substituting “10 cents”; and
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph (2) (b) “Ten cents” and substituting “20 cents”.
