To amend the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933*

CEMETERIES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Cemeteries (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.^{*} Short title

2. Section 16 of the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933*[†] is repealed and the following section substituted:

“16. A person shall not exhume a body, or the remains of a body, buried in a cemetery— Exhumation
of bodies

(a) except in pursuance of a warrant issued under the *Coroners Ordinance 1956*; or

(b) without the permission in writing of the Commissioner.

Penalty: \$100.”
