Transitional
provisions

6. (1) In this section, “ commencing day ” means—

- (a) in relation to the *Milk Authority Ordinance 1971*—
21 December 1977; and
- (b) in relation to any other Ordinance—the date on which this Ordinance is notified in the *Gazette*.

(2) An Ordinance specified in the Schedule, as amended by this Ordinance, applies to and in relation to an approval, appointment or determination given or made by the Treasurer under that Ordinance, as in force at any time before the commencing day, as if—

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the approval was given or the appointment or determination made; and
- (b) the approval had been given, or the appointment or determination had been made, as the case may be, by the Minister of State for Finance.

(3) An Ordinance specified in the Schedule, as amended by this Ordinance, applies to and in relation to an advance or payment made by the Treasurer for the purposes of that Ordinance before the commencing day as if—

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the advance or payment was made; and
- (b) the advance or payment had been made by the Minister of State for Finance.

(4) The *Housing Ordinance 1928*, as amended by this Ordinance, shall have effect as if—

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the Treasurer established a Trust Account for the purposes of section 5C of the *Housing Ordinance 1928*; and
- (b) the Trust Account had been established by the Minister of State for Finance for the purposes of the *Housing Ordinance 1928*, as amended by this Ordinance.
