PUBLIC HEALTH (PROHIBITED DRUGS) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1978*.* Short title
2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Ordinance 1957*.† Principal Ordinance
3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date fixed under section 2 of the *Poisons and Narcotic Drugs Ordinance 1978*. Commencement
4. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the definitions of "cannabis", "cannabis fibre", "cannabis plant" and "cannabis resin". Interpretation
5. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (2). Manufacture, use, possession, &c., of prohibited drugs
