MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Medical Practitioners Registration (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.^{*} Short title

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1930*.[†] Principal Ordinance

3. Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in sub-section (1) after paragraph (b) the following paragraph: Registration by the Board

"(ba) he holds the approved qualification, or each of the approved qualifications, referred to in an item in the Schedule;"

4. The Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following Schedule: Schedule
