ARCHITECTS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Architects (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.^{*} Short title
2. Section 6 of the *Architects Ordinance 1959* is amended— Members of the Board
 - (a) by omitting " the Canberra Area Committee of " from sub-section (3); and
 - (b) by omitting " Committee referred to in the last preceding sub-section " from sub-section (4) and substituting " Royal Australian Institute of Architects ".
3. Section 7 of the *Architects Ordinance 1959* is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section: Tenure of office

" (3) The performance of the functions of the Board is not affected by reason only of there being a vacancy or vacancies in the membership of the Board."
