### POISONS AND DANGEROUS DRUGS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title

2. Section 40B of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933*<sup>†</sup> is amended— Restrictions on supply of biological preparations, &c.

(a) by inserting after paragraph (a) the following paragraph:  
“ (aa) a registered dentist;” and

(b) by inserting in paragraph (f) “ , a registered dentist ” after  
“ medical practitioner ”.
