POLICE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1981

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police (Amendment) Ordinance 1981*.*

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Police Ordinance 1927*.†

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section substituted:

Interpretation

"4. In this Ordinance—

'Commissioner' or 'Commissioner of Police' means the Commissioner of Police of the Australian Federal Police;

'Police Force' means the Australian Federal Police."

Repeal of sections 5 to 12 (inclusive)

4. Sections 5 to 12 (inclusive) of the Principal Ordinance are repealed.
