An Ordinance to amend the *Poisons and  
Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933*

**Short title**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance 1981*.<sup>1</sup>

**Powers of inspection**

2. Section 10 of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting "or restricted substances" and substituting ", restricted substances and any other substances that are Schedule 4 or Schedule 8 substances within the meaning of the *Poisons and Narcotic Drugs Ordinance 1978*".
