An Ordinance to amend the *Consumer Affairs Ordinance 1973*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Consumer Affairs (Amendment) Ordinance 1981*.¹

Secrecy

2. Section 15E of the *Consumer Affairs Ordinance 1973*² is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (2) “3 months” and substituting “6 months, or both”;
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (3) “be required to”; and
- (c) by adding at the end of sub-section (3)—
“Penalty: \$1,000 or imprisonment for 6 months, or both.”.
