An Ordinance to amend the Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1981.¹

Interpretation

2. Section 4 of the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance* 1977² is amended by omitting "intoxicating liquor" (wherever occurring) from the definition of "offence involving alcohol or drugs" in sub-section (1) and substituting "alcohol".
