An Ordinance to amend the *Leases (Special Purposes)
Ordinance 1925*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Leases (Special Purposes) (Amendment) Ordinance 1981*.¹

2. Section 5B of the *Leases (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1925*² is repealed and the following section substituted:

Appeal against re-appraisalment

“5B. (1) Application may be made to the Tribunal for review of a re-appraisalment by the Minister under section 5A.

“(2) In this section, ‘Tribunal’ means the Administrative Appeals Tribunal established by the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975*.”.
