| <p>5. After section 6 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">" 6A. The Minister may, by notice in the <i>Gazette</i>, declare a preparation to be an approved insecticide in relation to a pest."</p> | <p>Approval of insecticides</p> |
