MOTOR TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1981

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1981*.*

Interpretation

2. Section 4 of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936*† is amended—

- (a) by omitting "1957-1966" from paragraph (a) of the definition of "drug" in sub-section (1) and substituting "1957";
- (b) by omitting "1933-1967" from paragraph (b) of the definition of "drug" in sub-section (1) and substituting "1933"; and
- (c) by omitting paragraph (c) of the definition of "drug" in sub-section (1) and substituting the following paragraph:
" (c) a substance that is a Schedule 8 substance or a Schedule 12 substance within the meaning of the *Poisons and Narcotic Drugs Ordinance 1978*;".
