An Ordinance to amend the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Theatres and Public Halls (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory by notice in the *Gazette*.

Prohibition or regulation of entertainments and meetings

3. Section 26 of the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928*² is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:

“(3) This section does not apply in relation to an authorized public assembly within the meaning of the *Public Assemblies Ordinance 1982*.”.
