An Ordinance to amend the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Licences to sell poisons, &c.

2. Section 8 of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933*² is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) "grant, on payment of the prescribed fee," and substituting "on payment of the prescribed fee to the Capital Territory Health Commission, grant".
