An Ordinance to amend the Holidays Ordinance 1958

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance* 1982.¹

Public holidays

- 2. Section 3 of the Holidays Ordinance 19582 is amended—
- (a) by inserting after sub-paragraph (1) (a) (vi) the following sub-paragraph:
 - "(via) the second Monday in June (the day for the observance of the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign);"; and
- (b) by omitting sub-paragraphs (1) (a) (ix) and (x) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:
 - "(ix) the twenty-sixth day of December (Boxing Day), or, if that day falls on a Sunday or a Monday, the following day; and".
