An Ordinance to amend the *Holidays Ordinance 1958*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Public holidays

2. Section 3 of the *Holidays Ordinance 1958*² is amended—

(a) by inserting after sub-paragraph (1) (a) (vi) the following sub-paragraph:

“(via) the second Monday in June (the day for the observance of the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign);” and

(b) by omitting sub-paragraphs (1) (a) (ix) and (x) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(ix) the twenty-sixth day of December (Boxing Day), or, if that day falls on a Sunday or a Monday, the following day; and”.
