An Ordinance to amend the *Health Professions Boards (Procedures) Ordinance 1981*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Health Professions Boards (Procedures) (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Proceedings to be in public

2. Section 26 of the *Health Professions Boards (Procedures) Ordinance 1981*² is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:

“(3) A person shall not fail to comply with a direction given by the Board in pursuance of paragraph (2) (b) or (c).

Penalty: \$1,000 or imprisonment for 6 months.”.
