An Ordinance to amend the *Machinery Ordinance 1949*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Machinery (Amendment) Ordinance 1983*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 October 1983.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Machinery Ordinance 1949*.²

4. After section 4 of the Principal Ordinance the following sections are inserted:

Power of Minister to determine fees

"4A. The Minister may, by notice in writing published in the *Gazette*, determine fees for the purposes of this Ordinance.

Fees payable

"4B. A fee determined under section 4A is payable to the Commonwealth in relation to the relevant matter specified in the notice referred to in that section, being a matter in respect of which the Minister may make regulations."

Regulations

5. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (2) (f).
