An Ordinance to amend the *Building and Services Ordinance 1924*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Building and Services (Amendment) Ordinance 1983*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 October 1983.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Building and Services Ordinance 1924*.²

4. After section 3E of the Principal Ordinance the following sections are inserted:

Power of Minister to determine fees

"3F. The Minister may, by notice in writing published in this *Gazette*, determine fees and charges for the purposes of this Ordinance."

Fees payable

“3G. A fee or charge determined under section 3F is payable to the Commonwealth in relation to the relevant matter specified in the notice referred to in that section, being a matter in respect of which the Minister may make regulations.”

Regulations

5. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting paragraph (1) (c); and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (1) (d) “and the fees payable therefor”.
