An Ordinance to amend the *Liquor Ordinance 1975*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited at the *Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for Territories and Local Government by notice in the *Gazette*.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Liquor Ordinance 1975*.²

Compulsory applications

4. Section 48 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in paragraph (b) “the *Unlawful Games Ordinance 1984*,” after “the *Police Offences Ordinance 1930*,”.

Cancellation of licences

5. Section 51 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in paragraph (1) (b) “the *Unlawful Games Ordinance 1984*,” after “the *Police Offences Ordinance 1930*,”.

Cancellation of permits

6. Section 66 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in paragraph (2) (b) “the *Unlawful Games Ordinance 1984*,” after “the *Police Offences Ordinance 1930*,”.
