An Ordinance to amend the *Fishing Ordinance 1967*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 22 August 1984.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Fishing Ordinance 1967*.²

Grant of licences

4. Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) “a fee of Two dollars” and substituting “the fee determined by the Minister under section 39A for the purposes of this sub-section”.

5. After section 39 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:

Power of Minister to determine fees

“39A. The Minister may, by notice in writing published in the *Gazette*, determine fees for the purposes of this Ordinance.”
