An Ordinance to amend the *Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) Ordinance 1981*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1984*.¹

Interpretation

2. Section 3 of the *Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) Ordinance 1981*² is amended by inserting after sub-section (1) the following sub-section:

2 *Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment)* No. 56, 1984

“(1A) For the purposes of this Ordinance, work consisting of planning, sewing or laying floor coverings shall be taken to be work performed in the building and construction industry.”
