An Ordinance to amend the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1986*.¹

Admission as barrister and solicitor

2. Section 10 of the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970*² is amended by inserting after paragraph (1) (ab) the following paragraph:

“(ac) he or she has been admitted, or is qualified for admission, to the degree of Bachelor of Laws at the Queensland Institute of Technology;”.
