An Ordinance to amend the *Unlawful Games Ordinance 1984*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Unlawful Games (Amendment) Ordinance 1987*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for Territories by notice in the *Gazette*.

Unlawful machines

3. Section 8 of the *Unlawful Games Ordinance 1984*² is amended:

(a) by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) All unlawful machines, other than machines installed on premises in accordance with the *Gaming Machine Ordinance 1987*, are forfeited to the Commonwealth.”; and

(b) by omitting from subsection (2) “*Poker Machine Control Ordinance 1975*” and substituting “*Gaming Machine Ordinance 1987*”.
