An Ordinance to amend the *Business Franchise (Tobacco and Petroleum Products) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1987*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Business Franchise (Tobacco and Petroleum Products) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 3) 1987*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 November 1987.

Saving

3. Section 16 of the *Business Franchise (Tobacco and Petroleum Products) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1987*² is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

“(2) Notwithstanding the amendments effected by paragraph 4 (c) and section 9 of this Ordinance, the fee to be paid for a petroleum wholesaler’s licence or a group petroleum wholesaler’s licence granted in respect of December 1987 is the fee that would have been payable if those amendments had not been made.”.
