An Ordinance to amend the *Liquor Ordinance 1975*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance 1988*.<sup>1</sup>

### Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 July 1988.

### Issue and transfer of Club Licences—conditions

3. Section 34 of the *Liquor Ordinance 1975*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting from paragraph (2) (d) “calendar year for the purposes of electing” and substituting “3 calendar years for the purpose of electing members of”.
