An Ordinance to amend the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 7) 1988*.¹

Riding in trailers prohibited

2. Section 186A of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936*² is amended by omitting from subsection (2) “remain” and substituting “wilfully be”.
