An Ordinance to amend the *Public Baths and Public Bathing Ordinance 1956*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Baths and Public Bathing (Amendment) Ordinance 1988*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance commences on such date as is fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Public Baths and Public Bathing Ordinance 1956*.²

Insertion

4. Before section 16 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted in Part III:

Interpretation

“15A. In this Part, ‘blind person’, ‘deaf person’, ‘guide dog’ and ‘hearing dog’ have the same respective meanings as in the *Dog Control Ordinance 1975*.”.

Offences

5. Section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (m) and substituting the following paragraph:

- “(m) cause or permit an animal belonging to, or under the control of, the person to enter or remain in—
- (i) if the animal is a guide dog accompanying a blind person or a hearing dog accompanying a deaf person—a swimming pool in any public baths; or
 - (ii) in any other case—any public baths;”.

Power of removal

6. Section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraph:

- “(d) remove an animal from—
- (i) if the animal is a guide dog accompanying a blind person or a hearing dog accompanying a deaf person—a swimming pool in the baths; or
 - (ii) in any other case—the baths.”.
