An Ordinance to amend the *Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Ordinance 1957*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance 1988*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance commences on such date as is fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

Schedule

3. The Schedule to the *Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Ordinance 1957*² is amended by omitting "Thalidomide" and "Zeranol".
