An Ordinance to amend certain Ordinances in relation to remuneration

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Remuneration (Miscellaneous Amendments) Ordinance 1989*.<sup>1</sup>

## AMENDMENTS OF OTHER ORDINANCES

***Agents Ordinance 1968*****Section 11**

Repeal the section, substitute the following section:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“11. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

***Architects Ordinance 1959*****Section 8**

- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

Repeal the section.

Omit the subsection.

Insert the following section:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

***Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965***

**Section 13**

Repeal the section, substitute the following sections:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“13. (1) A trustee shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) The Minister may make regulations for the purposes of subsection (1).

“(3) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a trustee; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a trustee.

***Careless Use of Fire Ordinance 1936*****Subsection 5A (4)**

Omit the subsection.

**After section 5G**

Insert the following section:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“5H. (1) A member of the Council shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

***Classification of Publications Ordinance 1983*****Section 14**

Repeal the section.

***Consumer Affairs Ordinance 1973*****Section 7**

Repeal the section, substitute the following section:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“7. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

***Credit Ordinance 1985***

**Leave of absence**

“187A. The Minister may grant leave of absence to a member, or to a person appointed to act as a member, upon such terms and conditions as to remuneration or otherwise as the Minister determines.

**Remuneration and allowances**

“188. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to the Commissioner.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

***Milk Authority Ordinance 1971*****Section 9**

Repeal the section, substitute the following sections:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“9. (1) A member of the Authority shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or

- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

***National Exhibition Centre Trust Ordinance 1976***

Repeal the section, substitute the following sections:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“10. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.

***Plumbers, Drainers and Gasfitters Board Ordinance 1982***

**Section 12**

Repeal the Section, substitute the following section:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“51. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

***Radiation Ordinance 1983***

**Section 16A**

Repeal the section, substitute the following section:

**Remuneration and allowances**

“16A. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

***Surveyors Ordinance 1967***

**Section 8**

Repeal the section, substitute the following section:

**SCHEDULE—continued**

**Remuneration and allowances**

“8. (1) A member shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed.

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in relation to—

- (a) remuneration if there is a subsisting determination relating to the remuneration to be paid to a member; or
- (b) an allowance of a particular kind if there is a subsisting determination relating to an allowance of that kind to be paid to a member.

“(3) In subsection (2), ‘determination’ means a determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.”
