

Drugs of Dependence (Amendment) Act 1991

No. 5 of 1991

An Act to amend the Drugs of Dependence Act 1989

[Notified in ACT Gazette S 7: 1 March 1991]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Drugs of Dependence (Amendment) Act 1991.*

Commencement

- **2.** (1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.
- (2) The remaining provisions commence on a day, or respective days, fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.
- (3) If a provision referred to in subsection (2) has not commenced before the end of the period of 6 months commencing on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*, that provision, by force of this subsection, commences on the first day after the end of that period.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Drugs of Dependence* Act 1989.¹
