Crimes (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1992

No. 76 of 1992

An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1900

[Notified in ACT Gazette S236: 24 December 1992]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Crimes (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1992*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Crimes Act 1900.1

Insertion

4. After section 545 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:

Fighting

"545A. A person shall not fight with another person in a public place. Penalty: \$1,000.".
