Subordinate Laws (Amendment) Act (No. 3) 1994

No. 106 of 1994

An Act to amend the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S289: 22 December 1994]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Subordinate Laws (Amendment) Act (No. 3) 1994*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.¹

Notification, tabling and disallowance

4. Section 6 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) “with paragraph (1) (a)” and substituting:

“with—

(a) paragraph (1) (a); and

- (b) any requirement in any Act or subordinate law that the first-mentioned subordinate law be published or notified in the *Gazette*.”.

Saving

5. The amendment effected by section 4 is to be taken to apply, and to have always applied, in relation to the gazettal of all subordinate laws made before the date of commencement of this Act.
