Air Pollution (Amendment) Act 1994

No. 22 of 1994

An Act to amend the *Air Pollution Act 1984*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S87: 20 May 1994]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Air Pollution (Amendment) Act 1994*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Air Pollution Act 1984*.¹

Sale of solid fuel-burning equipment

4. Section 24A of the Principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (1) (b) “has been issued in relation to it” and substituting “under subsection (3) has been issued in relation to equipment of the same type”; and
 - (b) by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:

“(3) For the purposes of paragraph (1) (b), an authorised person or body may certify, in relation to solid fuel-burning equipment of a particular type, that—

 - (a) equipment of that type has been tested (whether by that person or body, or by another person or body) in

accordance with the test procedure specified in AS 4013;
and

- (b) the authorised person or body is satisfied that the equipment tested had an appliance particulate emission factor not greater than the maximum allowable particulate emission factor specified in section 7 of AS 4013.”.
