Intoxicated Persons (Consequential Amendments) Act 1994

No. 86 of 1994

An Act to amend the *Coroners Act 1956* and the *Crimes Act 1900* consequent on the enactment of the *Intoxicated Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1994*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S280: 15 December 1994]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Intoxicated Persons (Consequential Amendments) Act 1994*.

Commencement

2. (1) Section 1 and this section commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.

(2) The remaining provisions commence on the day on which section 3 of the *Intoxicated Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1994* commences.

Coroners Act 1956

3. Section 2 of the *Coroners Act 1956* is amended—

- (a)** by omitting from paragraph (e) of the definition of “custodial officer” in subsection (1) “or” (last occurring);

- (b) by adding at the end of paragraph (f) of the definition of “custodial officer” in subsection (1) “or”;
 - (c) by adding at the end of the definition of “custodial officer” in subsection (1) the following paragraph:
 - “(g) a carer within the meaning of the *Intoxicated Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1994*.”;
 - (d) by omitting from paragraph (2) (d) “or” (last occurring);
 - (e) by adding at the end of paragraph (2) (e) “(other than a custodial officer referred to in paragraph (g) of the definition of ‘custodial officer’ in subsection (1)); or”;
 - (f) by inserting after paragraph (2) (e) the following paragraph:
 - “(f) while at a licensed place within the meaning of the *Intoxicated Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1994*.”;
- and
- (g) by omitting from subsection (2) “(e)” (last occurring) and substituting “(f)”.

Crimes Act 1900

4. Section 351 of the *Crimes Act 1900* is repealed.
