Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Act 1996

No. 48 of 1996

An Act to amend the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs)* Act 1977

[Notified in ACT Gazette S234: 19 September 1996]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs)* (*Amendment) Act 1996.*

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977*.¹

Interpretation

4. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the definition of "Commonwealth vehicle" and substituting the following definition:

- " 'Commonwealth vehicle' means a motor vehicle that is owned by the Commonwealth and—
 - (a) bears a label attached to the windscreen that displays the letter 'C' followed by a 7-pointed star, both in white against a blue background, and the word 'COMCAR' in blue against a white background; or
 - (b) is, or is within a class of motor vehicles that is, declared by the Minister, by instrument published in the *Gazette*, to be a Commonwealth vehicle for the purposes of this Act;".
