Animal Diseases (Amendment) Act 1997

No. 3 of 1997

An Act to amend the *Animal Diseases Act 1993* and for a related purpose

[Notified in ACT Gazette S60: 5 March 1997]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Animal Diseases (Amendment) Act 1997*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Animal Diseases Act 1993*.¹

Interpretation

4. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of “animal” and substituting the following definition:

“ ‘animal’ includes—

- (a) a vertebrate and an invertebrate;

- (b) a carcass of an animal; and
 - (c) an egg, embryo, ovum or sperm, or other product, of an animal from which another animal could be produced;
- but does not include a human being;”.

Repeal of *Apiaries Act 1928*

5. The *Apiaries Act 1928* is repealed.
