Crimes (Amendment) Act (No. 5) 1998

No. 71 of 1998

An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1900

[Notified in ACT Gazette S212: 23 December 1998]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Crimes (Amendment) Act (No. 5) 1998.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Crimes Act 1900. 1

4. Substitution

Section 428A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section substituted:

"428A. Application

This Part ceases to have effect on 30 June 1999.".
