Poisons and Drugs (Amendment) Act 1999

No. 27 of 1999

An Act to amend the *Poisons and Drugs Act 1978*

[Notified in ACT Gazette S22: 6 May 1999]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Poisons and Drugs (Amendment) Act 1999*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Poisons and Drugs Act 1978*.¹

4. Advertising scheduled substances

Section 48A of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

“(4) In subsection (1), a reference to a Schedule 3 substance shall be read as not including a reference to a Schedule 3 substance that is listed in Appendix H to the Drugs and Poisons Standard.”.
