Ambulance Service Levy (Amendment) Act 1999

No. 37 of 1999

An Act to amend the *Ambulance Service Levy Act 1990* and for related purposes

[Notified in ACT Gazette S44: 12 July 1999]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Ambulance Service Levy (Amendment) Act 1999*.

2. Commencement

This Act is taken to have commenced on 1 July 1999.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, “Principal Act” means the *Ambulance Service Levy Act 1990*.¹

4. Calculation of ambulance levy

Section 8 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting subsections (4) and (5);

- (b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of “relevant amount” in subsection (6) “fixes under subsection (4)” and substituting “determines under section 139 of the *Taxation Administration Act 1999* for the purposes of this section”; and
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (b) of the definition of “relevant amount” in subsection (6) “fixed—49” and substituting “determined—83”.

5. Returns

Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

“(2) A return shall be in writing in a form approved by the commissioner and shall specify, in relation to the reference month to which the return relates—

- (a) the number of contributors who are contributors only in respect of themselves;
- (b) the number of other contributors; and
- (c) the number of days in the reference month.”.

6. Consequential amendments of the Tax Administration Act

Section 139 of the *Taxation Administration Act 1999* is amended—

- (a) by adding at the end of subsection (1) the following paragraph:

“(h) an amount for the purposes of section 8 of the *Ambulance Service Levy Act 1990*.”; and
- (b) by omitting subsection (3).
