Financial Management Legislation Amendment Act 2001

No 45 of 2001

An Act to amend the *Financial Management Act 1996* and the *Territory Superannuation Provision Protection Act 2000*

[Notified in ACT Gazette No. 28: 12 July 2001]

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Financial Management Legislation Amendment Act 2001.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day fixed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.

- Note 1 The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on its notification day (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 75).
- Note 2 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 77 (1)).
- Note 3 If a provision has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 79).
