An Act to amend the *Public Place Names Act 1989*, and for other purposes

*Notified under the Legislation Act 2001 on 20 December 2002
(see www.legislation.act.gov.au)*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Public Place Names Amendment Act 2002*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Acts amended

- (1) This Act (other than section 6) amends the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.
- (2) Section 6 amends the *Districts Act 2002*.

4 Minister to determine names Section 3 (2)

- (2) If the Minister is making a determination about the naming of a division, or the naming of a public place after a person mentioned in section 4 (2) (a) or (b), the Minister must consider—
 - (a) the number of women and men after whom divisions or public places have been named in the last 10 years; and
 - (b) whether the names of women are well-represented.
