An Act to amend the Road Transport (General) Act 1999

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Road Transport (General) Amendment Act 2004 (No 2).

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Road Transport (General) Act 1999.

- (2) To remove any doubt, a third-party policy does not insure the owner or driver of a motor vehicle if—
 - (a) the motor vehicle is in an area that is subject to a declaration under section 12 that has the effect of disapplying part 10 (or part 10 and any other provision of the road transport legislation); or

- (b) the motor vehicle is subject to a declaration under section 13 that has the effect of disapplying part 10 (or part 10 and any other provision of the road transport legislation); or
- (c) the owner or driver is subject to a declaration under section 13 that has the effect of disapplying part 10 (or part 10 and any other provision of the road transport legislation).
- (3) Also, to remove any doubt, the reference to any other territory law in section 169 (1) does not include a reference to this section or a declaration made under section 12 or section 13.
