A2005-16

An Act to amend the *Workers Compensation Act 1951*, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Workers Compensation Amendment Act 2005*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the *Workers Compensation Act 1951*.

Note This Act also amends the *Workers Compensation Supplementation Fund Act 1980* (see s 7).
