# Administration (Interstate Agreements) Repeal Act 2005

An Act to amend and repeal the *Administration (Interstate Agreements) Act 1997*

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Administration (Interstate Agreements) Repeal Act 2005*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

**3 Legislation repealed**

The *Administration (Interstate Agreements) Act 1997* A1997-115 is repealed.

**4 Administration (Interstate Agreements) Act 1997, new section 5A**

*in part 1, insert*

**5A Ending of application of Act**

- (1) This Act ceases to apply in relation to interstate agreements and any negotiations for them.
- (2) Subsection (1) has effect despite the Legislation Act, section 84 (Saving of operation of repealed and amended laws).
- (3) This section is declared to be a law to which the Legislation Act, section 88 (Repeal does not end effect of transitional laws etc) applies.
