

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Amendment Act 2007

A2007-6

An Act to amend the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management)* Act 1999, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Amendment Act 2007.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999.

Note This Act also amends the Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005 (see s 5).

4 Driver or rider to stop and give assistance Section 16, penalty

Maximum penalty: 200 penalty units, imprisonment for 2 years or both.
